For Adoption of the Grimes County Hazard Mitigation Plan

WHEREAS Grimes County has experienced severe damage from wildfires, floods, droughts, and tornadoes on many occasions in the past century resulting in loss of life, property, economic hardship, and threats to public safety, health and security, and;

WHEREAS the Grimes County Hazard Mitigation Plan has been significantly updated within the past year with input from the local jurisdictions within Grimes County including a number of professionals and community members, and;

WHEREAS the Grimes County Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends many hazard mitigation actions that will protect the people and property affected by natural hazards that impact the county, and;

WHEREAS public meetings were held as required by law to review the Grimes County Hazard Mitigation Plan, mitigations actions, and the hazards profiled;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF ANDERSON:

1. That the Grimes County Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official mitigation plan for the Town of Anderson.
