RESOLUTION # 77-18**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ANDERSON, TEXAS, RECOGNIZING THE IMPORTANCE AND PUBLIC PURPOSE OF ANDERSON HOLIDAY FEST; AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSING OF DESIGNATED STREETS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ANDERSON HOLIDAY FEST AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RELATING TO THE CLOSURE OF SUCH DESIGNATED STREETS AND SETTING FORTH THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILTIES OF THE TOWN OF ANDERSON AND THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION DURING SUCH ANDERSON HOLIDAY FEST.

WHEREAS, Charlie Diggs Production and Entertainment will hold the Anderson Holiday Fest on December 15, 2018;

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen supports the efforts of Anderson Holiday Fest;

WHEREAS, certain streets will need to be closed during the Anderson Holiday Fest;

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation requires that an agreement be entered into between the town and the Department in order to authorize and facilitate the temporary closure of such streets, to wit: Loop 429 (Main Street) from 1774 to FM 149 E.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Anderson, Grimes County Texas:

Section 1 The following streets are closed temporarily during Anderson Holiday Fest being December 15, 2018 from 12 pm to 12 am.

Section 2 That staff from **Altus Traffic and Charlie Diggs Production & Entertainment** are hereby authorized to erect such barricades along those portions of said streets and/or from the commencement of, during and upon conclusion of Anderson Holiday Fest to insure pedestrian safety.


Section 3 The Mayor or her designee, is hereby authorized to seek approval of any and all permits or other documents required by Texas Department of Transportation to effect the temporary closing of said streets and/or highways for Anderson Holiday Fest, and to execute any documents or agreements required by Texas Department of Transportation to authorize the said closings and establishing the rights and duties and responsibility of the City and the State in connection therewith.
