

**Town of Anderson
Ordinance #:141-21**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ANDERSON, TEXAS, DIRECTING THE GRIMES COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE DEPARTMENT TO ERECT A STOP SIGN FOR ALL DIRECTIONS OF TRAFFIC AT THE INTERSECTION OF MAIN STREET AND WOODWARD AVENUE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Anderson provides that the Grimes County Road and Bridge Department shall install traffic control devices when directed to do so by ordinance of the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that, to protect the health and safety of its citizens, stop signs should be erected at an intersection in the Town of Anderson;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANDERSON, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Town Council hereby designates the intersection of Main Street and Woodward Avenue as a stop intersection and hereby directs the Grimes County Road and Bridge Department to cause the placement of a stop sign for all directions of traffic on Main Street at Woodward Avenue, such a stop sign to conform to the manual and specification adopted under Texas Transportation Code 544.001 and located in accordance with Texas Transportation Code 544.003.


SECTION 2. Immediately following the installation of the stop signs as set forth herein, the Grimes County Road and Bridge Department shall cause a written report to be filed thereof with the Town Clerk in accordance with the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3. All provisions of the Ordinances of the Town of Anderson, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, and all other provisions not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. If any article, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional for any reason, such judgment or holding shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and publication of the caption, as the law and charter in such cases provide.
