

MINUTES OF MEETING
OF
BOARD OF ALDERMEN
THE TOWN OF ANDERSON TEXAS
HELD ON THURSDAY, MARCH 9, 1995

State of Texas
County of Grimes

The Board of Aldermen of the Town of Anderson met in regular open session in the Board Room of the First National Bank in the Town of Anderson, at 7:00 P.M., Thursday, March 9, 1995, with the Mayor and all Alderman present.

The meeting was called to order at 7:06 p.m. The minutes from the previous two meetings were read. On a motion made by Alderman Johanson and seconded by Alderman Heyman the minutes were unanimously approved.

Alderman Heyman moved the adoption of an ordinance changing the length of terms of office of Aldermen from one to two year terms. The motion further provided that for the first term only two (2) aldermen will serve 2 year terms and three (3) aldermen will serve 1 year terms. Thereafter all aldermen will be elected for 2 year terms. The motion further provided that the aldermen draw lots to determine who will serve 1 year terms and who will serve 2 year terms. Alderman Blake seconded the motion. The motion was adopted unanimously. Aldermen next drew lots with Alderman F.D. Calhoun and Alderman Johanson drawing 2 year terms and the remaining 3 Aldermen drawing 1 year terms.

On a motion made by Alderman F.D. Calhoun, and seconded by Alderman Heyman, officers unanimously voted to approve the First National Bank of Anderson as the official depository of the Town of Anderson.

Following a discussion, a motion was made by Alderman Blake and seconded by Alderman Thomas, authorizing the Mayor to

negotiate a loan with the First National Bank of Anderson, in an amount not to exceed \$2000 to fund the most essential needs of the Town. The motion was adopted by unanimous vote.

Officers discussed a budget proposal presented by the Mayor. No action was taken pending additional preparation.

Officers discussed the necessity of interlocal agreements between Grimes County and Town for law enforcement and road maintenance.

The Mayor announced that the pre-application for FMHA loan was approved. Officers discussed the need for a special meeting on March 30, 1995, to meet with FMHA officers.


Officers discussed the option of tax rates up to \$.25 per \$100 valuation maximum. No motions were made pending a formal budget to be prepared and approved by Town officers.

Officers unanimously approved Mayor Freeman to serve on the BVDC board representing the Town of Anderson.

Officers discussed "Beautify Anderson" program.

The meeting was adjourned on a motion made by Alderman Thomas and seconded by Alderman Blake at 8:12 P.M.
