

MINUTES OF MEETING  
OF  
BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
THE TOWN OF ANDERSON TEXAS  
HELD ON APRIL 10, 1997

The Board of Aldermen of the Town of Anderson met in regular open session in the American Legion Building in Anderson at 7:00 P. M., Thursday, April 10, 1997, with the following officers present: John S. Freeman, Mayor, F.D. Calhoun, Alderman, Gail Sowell, Alderwoman, Tom Johanson, Alderman, and with Alderman Norman Blake and Alderman David Heyman absent.

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 P.M. by Mayor Freeman.

Representatives of Entergy appeared before the Board of Aldermen to inform them of changes being implemented. The primary changes discussed were improvements in responding to requests of customers and also "streamlining" to increase the coast efficiency of Entergy. These changes mentioned, and others, are being implemented in preparation for anticipated state-wide deregulation of electrical utilities.

Alderman Johanson moved that the minutes of the meeting held on March 20, 1997, be approved as presented. Alderman, F.D. Calhoun seconded the motion. The motion was adopted by unanimous vote.

Alderman F.D. Calhoun moved that payments to Sprint-United Telephone Co. in the amount of \$32.27 and to Am. Legion Post 640 in the amount of \$225 be approved. Alderwoman Gail Sowell seconded the motion. The motion was passed by unanimous vote.

The delay in getting earth borings in the immediate area of the proposed treatment and stabilization ponds was discussed.

The designation of a date, or dates, to conduct street clean drive was discussed. No specific dates were suggested pending a determination of when TDC work crews might be available and also when ditches might have dried sufficiently to enable crews to do the work efficiently.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
