

MINUTES OF MEETING  
OF  
BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
THE TOWN OF ANDERSON TEXAS  
HELD ON MARCH 12, 1998

The Board of Aldermen of the Town of Anderson met in regular open session in the American Legion Building in Anderson, Texas at 7:00 P. M., Thursday, March 12, 1998. The Mayor, Aldermen Blake, Johanson, and Sowell were present.

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 P.M. by Mayor Freeman.

On a motion made by Alderman Johanson and seconded by Alderman Sowell, officers present unanimously voted to approve minutes from the January 8, 1998, and February 12, 1998 council meetings.

On a motion made by Alderman Johanson, and seconded by Alderman Blake, officers present unanimously voted to approve the payment of routine bills, and the following payments: \$60.24 to Hart Information Services, \$49.95 to re-imburse the Mayor for buying a warranty for the copier/fax machine/answering machine, \$229 to the Appraisal District, and \$18.82 to Mrs. Maurine Wehmeyer for copying a map of Anderson.

Officers present then discussed the NPDES application for permit to discharge wastewater and the approval of a proposed bond ordinance by the office of General Counsel of USDA Rural Development.

Officers present briefly discussed the procurement of easements necessary for the installation of sewage lines.

Officers present discussed the possible necessity of an election. The deadline for filing is March 18, 1998.

Mayor Freeman then advised the officers that a workshop will be held soon sponsored by the TML for required training in management and investment of public funds. The Mayor plans to attend.

Ronnie Hale from Entergy was present and fielded questions from the Board about possible upcoming changes in energy production.

The meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
