

RESOLUTION NO. 108-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANDERSON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT DISASTER RECOVERY (CDBG-DR) APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR MAYOR PRO-TEM TO ACT AS THE TOWN'S EXECUTIVE OFFICERS AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE TOWN'S PARTICIPATION IN THE CDBG-DR PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Anderson, Texas desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing, a suitable living environment, and explain economic opportunities for all citizens including person of low to moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist related to flooding that occurred during an eligible federally declared emergency disaster in 2017 which represent a threat to the public health and safety; an

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the residents of the Town of Anderson to apply for funding under the CDBG-DR program, and that such grant be administered by the Town's executive officers as authorized herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANDERSON THAT:

1. That a CDBG-DR application is hereby authorized to be filled with the Texas General Land Office for funding consideration under the state non-housing completion.
2. That the application will not exceed \$500,000 to provide infrastructure improvements for the Town of Anderson.
3. The Anderson Town Council designates the Mayor and/or Mayor Pro-Tem as the Chief Executive Officers and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and participation in the CDBG-DR Program. The authorized official(s) is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, after or terminate the grant on behalf of the Town of Anderson.
4. That all the funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal state and local and programmatic requirements, including, but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition, and civil rights requirements.
