

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF Anderson, TEXAS
DENYING THE APPLICATION OF ENTERGY GULF STATES, INC.,
FOR APPROVAL OF ITS STATEMENT OF INTENT AND APPLICATION FOR
AUTHORITY TO CHANGE RATES


The City Council of the City of Anderson ("City") makes the following findings of fact:

1. On November 30, 1998, Entergy Gulf States, Inc. ("Entergy Texas" or "the Company"), filed its *STATEMENT OF INTENT AND APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY TO CHANGE RATES* ("application") with the City. The application seeks approval for new base rate tariffs.
2. On December 29, 1998, the City held a hearing in which Entergy Texas addressed the City Council regarding the application. In addition, the Anderson City Council has reviewed the application.
3. The proposed tariffs should be considered on a Texas service territory wide basis.

Consequently, based on these findings of fact,


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Anderson that the application is denied in order to allow for an appeal that will result in a decision applicable throughout the Company's Texas service territory.
